There are some new pictures of Steve on the Picture


Pages, taken from an interview on New Zealand TV!

There will be a Spotlighted Member of the Month named each month in the newsletter! Scroll down and see if it's *you*!


If anyone has an idea for something new to add to the website, please let me know.




Steve's wee newsletter blurb


